NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Council of the City of San Bruno will conduct a public hearing per Elections Code Section 10010 on **Tuesday, October 19, 2021, at 5:00 p.m.**, at which the City Council will 1) receive a report from staff on the transition from at-large elections to by-district elections for members of the City Council; and 2) conduct a public hearing to receive public input on communities of interest and potential district boundaries.

All interested persons are invited to attend said hearing and express opinions relating to this matter.

This meeting will be conducted telephonically pursuant to State of California Assembly Bill 361, which was signed by Governor Gavin Newsom on September 16, 2021. Accordingly, council members will be present remotely; they will not be physically present in the council chambers. Participation via electronic means is encouraged.
