Redistricting Rules and Goals

1. Federal Laws

Equal Population

Federal Voting Rights Act

No Racial Gerrymandering

2. California Criteria for Cities

- 1. Geographically contiguous
- Undivided neighborhoods and "communities of interest" (Socio-economic geographic areas that should be kept together)
- 3. Easily identifiable boundaries

4. Compact

(Do not bypass one group of people to get to a more distant group of people)

Prohibited: "Shall not favor or discriminate against a political party."












